Option #1: 4-Week Illustration Programme | £150 per session | Max. 20 students per session



Week 1: Pin Badges
Create 2 custom illustrated pin badges.

Week 2: Create A Puzzle
Draw your own jigsaw puzzle and then play 'Puzzle Pirate'.

Week 3: Draw On A Mug
Turn a simple mug into a ceramic masterpiece.

Week 4: T-Shirt Design
Create a fantastic piece of wearable art.

Option #2: 4-Week Animation Programme | £150 per session | Max. 20 students per session



Week 1: Paint Cars
Use acrylic markers to paint the wooden car parts

Week 2: Decorate Set
Make trees and paint the race track to finish off the set.

Week 3: Capture Frames
Set up 2 cameras and capture animation frames.

Week 4: Edit Animation
Arrange frames and add sound to complete animation.

Option #3: 6-Week Illustration Programme | £140 per session | Max. 20 students per session



Week 1: Make Pin Badges

Create your name badge and one custom illustrated pin badge.



Week 2: Draw A Poster

Create a giant poster based on word prompts.



Week 3: Create A Puzzle

Draw your own jigsaw puzzle and then play 'Puzzle Pirate'.



Week 4: Draw On A Mug

Use acrylic pens to turn a simple mug into a ceramic masterpiece.



Week 5: Draw On A Hat

Use fabric pens & fabric paint to create a cool hat.



Week 6: Draw On A T-Shirt

Use stencils, fabric pens & fabric paint to create a fantastic piece of wearable art.

Option #4: 8-Week Illustration & Animation Programme | £130 per session | Max. 20 students per session



Week 1: Pin Badges
 Create 2 custom illustrated pin badges.



Week 3: Create A Puzzle
 Draw your own jigsaw puzzle and then play puzzle pirate.




Week 4: Draw On A Mug

 Use fabric pens & fabric paint to create a unique hat.




Week 5: T-Shirt Design

 We will set up 2 cameras around the set and bring the car race to life through the magic of stop motion animation.



Weeks 8: Edit Animation
